While being an integral part of the GLOBSEC organisation, it focuses on research which is relevant to decision-makers, business leaders and all citizens concerned. Only rarely is our annual cycle divided into such contrasting halves. While the first one was a rather normal one – with two of our three flagship events, Tatra Summit 2019 and Château Béla 2019, happening in their usual autumn slot and an opening of our first foreign office in Brussels in January 2020 – the second one was anything like it. Due to the coronavirus pandemic, our most important event, the GLOBSEC Bratislava Forum, was re-scheduled twice from its usual late-spring time, only to be held in a hybrid format in October 2020. That is the main reason why this edition of GLOBSEC Overview looks different than its previous versions. However, there is another reason for this. The turbulent situation brought by the pandemic forced us to turn our

All the experience gained by organising these online events came in handy in October 2020 when we organised both the Bratislava Forum 2020 and Tatra Summit 2020 in a hybrid format in four days. But that will surely be the focus of the next edition of our annual overview.




The following part contains some basic information on the finances of the GLOBSEC organization in the annual cycle July 2019/ July 2020.





GLOBSEC Funding from Slovak Government




Tatra Summit 2019 Sources of Funding
