Executive Summary

The GLOBSEC Cyber Risk Project aims to conduct research to examine specific cyber risks, predict their future trajectory, and provide solutions to alleviate their impact. Emphasising the interdisciplinary approach that cyber risk evaluation necessitates, the risks will be broadly classified under three categories namely, **technology, society, and policy**. The aim of the year-long exercise is to cater to the dynamic nature of cyber risks and their interconnectedness with the aim of generating a more holistic picture of the defined risks.

Each risk under the Technology, Society, and Policy themes will be analysed through white papers which will be authored by various experts from different stakeholder groups (industry, policy, civil society, government) and the GLOBSEC Policy Institute.
